MyEd Student Portal Login

1. **Log on to MyEd BC** <https://www.myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen/>
2. **Log in ID** This is your student number. (the one on your ID card)
3. **Password:** Enter the password you used when doing course planning last spring. If you have not logged on before, try Atss2019\$ as the password (Password is case sensitive)

When you log in for the first time, or the first time using a new temporary password, you will be prompted immediately to change your password. ***Don't let the big red X scare you***, it just means you must create a new password. The requirements for the password are supplied below. Please make note of this password, you will need it again.




Now you are logged on:

4. Take some time to look around and get familiar with the program. Go to the “My Info” tab on the top. Here you will see some basic information about the student.
5. Click on the “Current Schedule” side tab and have a look at the semester 2 timetable.

You will receive another email when Report Cards are ready to view. Not all report cards will become available at the same time, so don't be concerned if your child's classmate receives theirs before yours becomes available.

6. **Forgot your password?**

Enter your User Name (student number) and click on the “Forgot Password” link. A new box will pop up that looks like this:



You must enter the same email that you assigned to your account last year. Once you have done this, you will get another new pop up with the security question you chose last year. You must answer with the same answer you supplied before. Once done, a new temporary password will be sent to your email account. Again, as soon as you sign in, using this password, you will be prompted to change your password again.

Still can't get logged on? Send an email to ATSS@abbyschools.ca using the email address that you want your temporary password sent to. ***Don't forget to give us the name of the student. Do not*** phone, as we need the email address to reset the password. This will now be the email associated with this login. So please take note of it.

Pants, dress casual (cords are acceptable).....	Black & Beige

Short-Sleeved Polo, with school crest.....	Black, Red & Beige
Tank Top, <u>only</u> for layering under uniform.....	Black, Beige or Red
Pants, dress casual (cords are acceptable) (no stretch or yoga pants).....	Black & Beige
Capris, dress casual.....	Black & Beige
Walking Shorts, dress casual, knee length.....	Black & Beige
Skirt, no shorter than knee length.....	Black & Beige

Unisex Items:

¼ Zip Sweater, with school crest.....	Black & Red

Gym Strip:

PE Shorts, with school crest.....	Black

Restrictions:

- All tops must have the school crest.
- Pants, shorts, capris and skirts are not to have zip off legs, chains, logos or other ornamentation. They are to be plain in style and appearance and conform to a dress pant style. No leggings, rugby pants, stretch pants etc....
- Boys are allowed to wear white undershirts provided they do not hang out the bottom of their polo shirt.
- Girls are allowed to layer tank tops under their shirt provided they are red, beige or black.
- No skin showing at mid section.
- All Shorts and shirts must no shorter than three finger widths above knee length
- Gym Strip is not to be worn in classes other than gym.
- Sweatpants are a gym strip item only, not to be worn in classes other than gym.




Step 3: Find Student
