Parents please note the following addition to our School Code of Conduct:

 Refrain from the use of personal electronic devices during instructional time for Grades 9-12 and during school hours for Grade 6-8. Personal electronic devices may include cell phones, smart watches, air pods/headphones, and other similar devices.
