Grade 9's must choose English, Math, Science, Social Studies, Careers, PE, 3 electives and two alternates. Electives must include at least 1 Fine Arts and 1 Applied Skills course.

Grade 10's must choose English, a Math, Science, Social Studies, Career Life Education, one PE 10 course, 2 electives and 2 alternates.

Grade 11's must choose English, a Social Studies, a Science, a Math, 4 electives and 2 alternates.

Grade 12's must choose English 12, Contemporary Indigenous Studies, Career Life Connections 12, 6 electives and 2 alternates.

All students working towards a B.C. Certificate of Graduation must successfully complete at least 4 credits in Indigenous-focused coursework.
