Registration for September 2025 is opening February 3 at 8:30AM! Parents of grade 5's who are attending Elementary schools other than King or South Poplar need to apply, remember, siblings are only given priority enrollment if they apply on February 3! If you have family members or friends who are interested in the Traditional model of education, please let them know that they can pick up application packages now from our office. Any questions please contact Ms. Jones (Kendall.jones@abbyschools.ca). Please note, a last minute change means online applications will not be open this year. If you were planning to apply online, please complete the application (from our office or website) and you can email your completed application package including all support documentation to Ms. Jones starting February 3 at 8:30AM. **WEATHER WARNING: If the forecasted snow over the weekend results in our school being closed on Monday, registration will be pushed to the next open school day. This is for both in person and by email. Please check the abbyschools.ca website for school closure information.**

Parent parking considerations: On Monday (or the next open school day) during registration, there will be several additional vehicles in the parking lot closest to the office. Please take this into consideration when dropping off your students. You may want to consider dropping them off early (they are welcome to come inside and sit in the student lounge until classes start). You could also park on one of the side streets a short distance away from the school and have your student walk to the school.
