Abbotsford Martens Street Project – PAC Parent Update

What We Know So Far

From BC Housing

- We received some responses, but most were redirected to their website (letstalkhousingbc.ca/abbotsford-martens-street) or to email communityrelations@bchousing.org.
- While some information is online, many of our specific questions remain unanswered.
- **Important Update:** In recent media reports, BC Housing has now confirmed that a **Safe Consumption Room will be included on-site**. This was not shared at the July 14 info session, on their website, or in earlier responses to us.

From the City of Abbotsford

- The project will go through review by City departments before moving forward.
- However, many of our questions have been redirected back to BC Housing.
- The City has not yet received the full application from BC Housing.

From the Abbotsford School District

- Senior leadership (including the Board Chair and Vice Chair) will be meeting with BC Housing in late September.
- They have committed to sharing updates after that meeting.
- Their stated priority is the **safety of students and staff**.

Key Questions Still Unanswered

- How and when will information from these meetings be shared with PACs, DPAC, and the broader school community?
- What opportunities will families have to provide **meaningful feedback** before decisions are finalized?
- Why was the Safe Consumption Room not disclosed earlier, and how will BC Housing rebuild community trust?
- Are **other locations** being considered for this project, given ATS's proximity and the concerns raised?
