Our lost and found (outside the MPR) is overflowing! We've got uniforms, PE clothes, hoodies, pants, water bottles ...you name it, it's probably there.

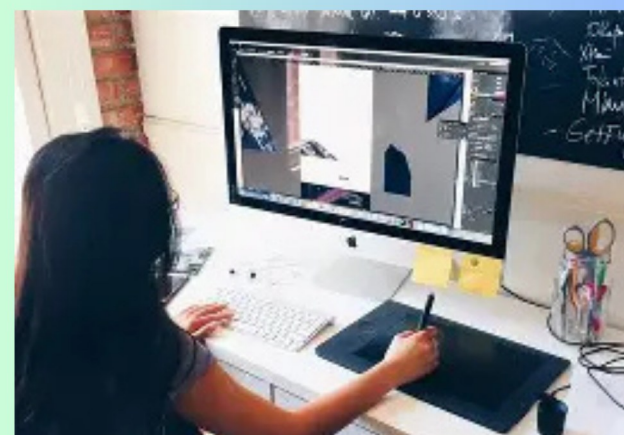
Please remind your student to stop by and check for any missing items before the end of next week. Anything left behind will be donated after that.
